Welcome to Lakehead University's **55**TH **CONVOCATION CELEBRATION!**

Convocation is a traditional ceremony during which the University officially grants the degrees and diplomas earned by its students. The word "convocation" means "calling together." It is a ceremonial meeting of the entire University community.

Academic Regalia

On Convocation Day, University members and their guests wear special attire based on a tradition that dates back as long as seven centuries ago. The academic costume, also referred to as academic "dress" or "regalia," had its origins in the medieval European universities. The regalia were devised to distinguish academic persons as doctors, licentiates, masters, and bachelors.

There are many variations of academic dress. The hood, gown, and in some cases the special hat worn by an individual are determined by the style of the university where he or she receives a degree. The colourful gowns and hoods of the universities from across Canada, the United States, the United Kingdom, and several other nations of the world are worn at Lakehead University today.

The academic dress chosen by Lakehead University is fashioned after that of the University of Oxford, the oldest English-speaking university in the world. The robes worn by the officers of the

University – the Chancellor, who presides at convocation, the President and Vice-Chancellor and the Chair of the Board of Governors – are all of the Oxford cut and trim. Each has its own distinctive colour. The colourful gowns worn by the individuals who are receiving honorary degrees are of the same design as are the black gowns worn by the student candidates.

The ritual at convocation reflects the medieval custom that anyone in a university could wear a gown, but a hood was the symbol of a degree. Students who have met the University's academic requirements (three, four, five, six or seven years of study in particular subjects) wear the symbol of their status as holders of a Lakehead University degree. Lakehead University's bachelor's and master's degree hoods are distinguished by a one or two inch colour border which indicates the degree acquired (i.e. white for Arts, gold for Science, blue for Education, burgundy for Nursing, etc).

The Mace

During the processional and the recessional, the Marshal for convocation carries the Mace, a silver wand which is a traditional symbol of the University's authority. This mace was given to the University by the Alumni Association in 1971. It bears the University's motto "Ad augusta per angusta", *Achievement through effort*.

Honorary **DEGREES**

The University confers "honorary" degrees which symbolize the highest honour that can be conferred upon an individual by the University. An honorary degree may be awarded in recognition of scholarly or creative achievements or distinguished public service to the country or region. They are awarded to individuals who have been designated by the University's Senate, its senior academic governing body a deserving special honour.

At Convocation, the degree is awarded honoris causa, or "for the sake of honour". A hood is also given to the recipient and it may be worn to any academic affair. Recipients of these degrees become honorary alumni of the University and they may affix, after their names, the abbreviation of the degree.

CHARLES PACHTER

Doctor of Fine Arts

Charles Pachter is one of Canada's most distinguished and internationally recognized contemporary artists.

A painter, printmaker, sculptor, designer, historian, and lecturer, Pachter has his work hanging in public and private collections throughout Canada, and internationally. His images of the Queen, moose, and maple leaf flag are considered icons of Canadian contemporary art.

Pachter studied French literature at the Sorbonne in Paris, painting and graphics at the Cranbrook Academy of Art in Michigan, and art history at the University of Toronto.


Pachter's paintings hang in the Portrait Gallery of Canada, the Canadian Embassy in Washington, Canada House in London, the Parliament Buildings, the Embassy of France, and in the Prime Minister's residence in Ottawa.

In Canada, Pachter has been decorated with the Order of Canada and the Order of Ontario, and is a recipient of the Queen's Golden and Diamond Jubilee medals. He is also a Chevalier of France's Order of Arts and Letters.

MARK DOUGLAS Biidaanakwad (Cloud approaching) Maang Dooodem (loon)

Mark Douglas is Anishinaabe from Rama First Nation and Golden Lake. A Storyteller, Mark has dedicated his life to building bridges between the Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities within the County of Simcoe.

Mark has held many positions in his varied career. He has been a police officer, a welfare officer, and an addictions counsellor. He was the Executive Director of the Ogemawahj Tribal Council, where he helped ensure that Indigenous art and culture were part of the building of Casino Rama. He has lectured for Georgian College, and worked for the Ontario government within the Native Community Branch.

Through these experiences, Mark learned to grow and understand different perspectives. He learned how to help others achieve their goals and assist them in seeing their potential. He has put these skills to work within the community to support youth, and encourage social interaction and cultural teaching.

Mark has had a formidable impact on Lakehead University through his story telling, knowledge keeping, knowledge sharing, activism and leadership. For over 11 years, he has distilled his learnings, visions and dreams into teachings and delivered them to students, staff and faculty in meaningful ways.

A father, grandfather, uncle and husband of 47 years, Mark enjoys spending his time contributing to community through story-telling, interacting with Elders and community members, and assisting with repatriating cultural protocols. Otherwise, you can find him driving around checking out local coffee shops and enjoying what they have to offer.
